Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower or higher height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

#### DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/ Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a (PAL/ILP) number or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four (4) months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

# **EO/WORLD TEAM TRYOUT QUALIFICATIONS**

Clear ISC Agility and Jumpers rounds from any level can be used to fulfill the requirements for the Team USA European Open Team Tryouts. Clear rounds from Levels 2 and 3 can be used to fulfill the requirements for Team USA Agility World Championship tryouts. Dogs must jump at their international height for ISC scores to count towards tryout qualifications.

#### **INTERNATIONAL SWEEPSTAKES CUP (ISC)**

**Purpose:** The International Sweepstakes Class (ISC) is a non-regular class providing the dog and handler an opportunity to demonstrate their advanced training and handling skills on various International Style Standard and Jumpers with Weaves courses. The rules for this class are generally based on international rules. The variety in International Agility course designs is very diverse, so handlers should be prepared to meet the "Challenge of the Day" when competing in the ISC class. The total challenge level may be easier, more difficult, or simply different from what is currently allowed in Excellent / Master Class. Complete rules for the ISC are available from the AKC Website (http://www.akc.org).

#### Eligibility:

ISC classes are open to dogs that are eligible to compete in AKC agility trials. There is no Preferred Option for ISC; dogs may enter at their preferred jump height, however they will be scored against the regular division dogs jumping the same jump height.

#### Jump Heights:

DOGS MAY BE ENTERED IN THEIR REGULAR JUMP HEIGHTS, however, only those dogs running in the 12", 16", 20" and 24" class that meet the FCI/ISC measuring cutoff (different than regular AKC cutoffs) may use their clean run toward the required qualification toward entering WTT or EOTT. Please see the 2022 EO/AWC Tryout Rules for further details.

#### The FCI/ISC cutoffs for those heights are as follows:

Small (12" jump height) - for dogs measuring 13 3/4" or less at the withers

Medium (16" jump height) – for dogs measuring more than 13 3/4" and up to 16 7/8" at the withers

Intermediate (20" jump height) – for dogs measuring more than 16 7/8 but less than 18 7/8" at the withers.

Large (24" jump height) – for dogs measuring over 16 7/8" at the withers **Obstacles:** 

Obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the AKC regulations for Agility Trials plus the viaduct jump.

**Scoring:** Time plus faults. Faults and refusals are each 5 second penalties. Time penalty is 1 second for each secopnd over time. Faults are dropped bars, missed contacts. A wrong course is an elimination. 3 Refusals is an elimination.

#### CHANGE OF ENTRY

Chapter 1, Section 21 of the Regulations for Agility Trials, a dog which is entered in a Novice A class for which it is not eligible may be moved to Novice B. If notification has been received from AKC after closing that a dog is not eligible for a class entered, the dog may be moved to the correct class. The request for the move must be made at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. If a VMO or Field Representative at the trial measures a dog into a height other than what they were entered, the entry may be changed from Regular to Preferred or from Preferred to Regular as long as that dog has not run in any classes that day. If that dog has already run, the change may be made for the next days trial. Exhibitor must provide the Trial Secretary with the AKC Agility Measurement Form when requesting the class change.

#### "AFTER CLOSING" WAIT LIST

A waiting list (30 run maximum each day) will be maintained for these trials once they have closed on Friday, November 24, 2023 at 6:00PM (EST). The waiting list will be active until its deadline-Monday, December 4, 2023 6:00PM (EST). Any runs that are entered in these trials at closing and pulled before the wait list deadline will be replaced, if possible, by runs in order on the wait list, and the exhibitor will be reimbursed in full. If a run cannot be replaced, the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent for the run. Entry fees for runs on the wait list that do not get into the trial by the wait list close date will be refunded in full.

#### NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

**THE SAFETY of the dog** is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by Action of the Event Committee. **NBCC** may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions. Entry fees will not be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an actof God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond control of the organizing committee.

Bitches in season are not allowed to compete in AKC Agility Trials, the club will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fee per run for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The trial secretary must receive written notification from a veterinarian of such claim for refund by letter hand delivered, emailed or postmarked before the trial commences.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. **NBCC** has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs.

Entries must be made on Official AKC entry forms or copies and must include the signed Agreement and Rules. Junior Handlers must enter their JH# and complete back of form.

All owners of mixed breed dogs must first obtain an AKC Canine Partners listing number before they may enter an AKC Agility Event. The dogs breed name should be entered as "All American Dog". The dogs listing number must be entered on the entry form

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms., whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date. Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on show grounds of AKC Agility Trials.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccination.

NBCC does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event. **Returned checks** do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$25 returned check fee. No refunds will be issued for overpayments of less than \$10. Checks for cancelled or incomplete entries will be shred-ded. No check will be returned.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their (dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund.

#### Entering for Exhibition Only (FEO)

· FEO will be offered in all ISC classes

• FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es)(ISC) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trail Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the Handler will declare the day of the show.

• Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.

• The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and judge Fix and Go (FNG)

• Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run. It allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a score of elimination for that round. All rights to televise, videotape, advertise, photograph or otherwise exploit this event are vested with Nutmeg Border Collie Club or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the Club. Photographs and/or video recordings taken for any reason other than personal use are strickly prohibited.

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners<sup>SM</sup> program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
